- WHAT:** An **Indiana Pesticide Clean Sweep Project** designed to collect and dispose of suspended, canceled, banned, unusable, opened, unopened or just unwanted pesticides (weed killers, insecticides, rodenticides, fungicides, miticides, etc.) is being sponsored by the Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC). This disposal service is free of charge up to 250 pounds per participant. Over 250 pounds there will be a \$2.00 per pound charge. This is a great opportunity for you to legally dispose of unwanted products at little or no cost.
- WHO:** All public and private schools, golf courses, nurseries, cities, towns, municipalities and county units of government or others receiving this notice are eligible to participate.

August 6, 2009: Hamilton County Fairgrounds in Noblesville, IN

- HOW:** Complete the enclosed **Pesticide Clean Sweep Planning Form** to the best of your ability. Mail, fax or e-mail the completed form to Kevin Neal at 765-494-4331 or nealk@purdue.edu no later than **Tue., July 28, 2009**. Then bring your labeled, leak free and safe to transport containers to the collection site. **DO NOT** mix materials. In case of an emergency, you should bring with you a list of products you are carrying and a contact phone number.
- *NOTE:** OISC reserves the right to cancel this Pesticide Clean Sweep Project if there is not adequate demand. Participants submitting the enclosed planning form by July 28, 2009 will be contacted immediately if cancellation is necessary.
